



SARDEOLICA'S ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Sardeolica considers respect for, and protection of, the environment of primary importance to its activities in the territory in which it operates.

The criteria on which Sardeolica bases the management of its activities provide for prior assessment of possible environmental impact, the adoption of the best available technologies and maximum transparency and cooperation with society at large and with the authorities. It actively involves all those who spend time at its site in environmental protection, whether they are its own personnel or external people.

Even though the generation of power from wind energy is, in and of itself, an activity with low-environmental impact, it is Sardeolica's belief that, by introducing its Environmental Management System and applying it to the power generation units located at Corte 'e Porcus, Fenarbu, Larenzu and Perda Fitta in the Municipality of Ulassai, it is possible to achieve, in addition to due respect for regulations in effect, the objective of continually improving environmental performance, in particular with respect to:

- the consumption of energy, water and auxiliary materials;
- waste production;
- the prevention of all forms of pollution.

Sardeolica is convinced that it is possible to reach these objectives only with the active contribution of all personnel, which is why it has developed, and continues to develop, a far-reaching information system.

Everyone who works at Sardeolica has direct responsibility for implementing the Company's environmental policy. Management has the very first responsibility in this regard.

Sardeolica is committed to spreading its environmental policy and to requiring that its tenderers, suppliers and any other party accessing its site for work-related reasons comply with this policy. Responsibility, proper behaviour and consideration regarding all environmental aspects are primary to assessment of performance quality.

Sardeolica is committed to ensuring the human and technical resources necessary to fulfilling and maintaining its environmental policy at the Ulassai production units.
