Since October 2018 she is the spokeperson of the Italian Minister of Economy and Finance, Giovanni Tria. She has been for more than 20 years the European correspondent in Brussels for II Sole–24Ore, the leading economic and financial newspaper in Italy. From 2011 and before leaving II Sole, she was columnist based in Brussels for Europe, Nato, trade and global issues.

Before going into journalism, Adriana Cerretelli was a researcher at the Istituto di Studi di Politica internazionale (ISPI) in Milan.

In 2000 the President of the Republic of Italy, Carlo Azeglio Ciampi, appointed her "Officer of the Italian Republic" for the contribution given with her reports to the birth of the Euro. In 2014 the President of France, Francois Hollande, awarded her with the Legion of Honour for her analyses on France and Europe.

She won several journalism awards in Italy and the European Parliament Prize for Journalism.
